

#### DREAM BIG! SCHOLARSHIP 2020

**Description:** The Dream Big! Scholarship Fund was established in 2004 by the Seattle Housing Authority (SHA) Higher Education Project to provide scholarship support for qualified students living in SHA subsidized housing.

**Availability:** At least two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in 2020.

**Eligibility** (applicants must meet all of the criteria below):

- Living in Seattle in Seattle Housing Authority subsidized housing.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 from most recent school attended (high school or college).
- Age 21 or under on May 1, 2020.
- Will have graduated from high school or obtained a GED by September 1, 2020.
- Will attend college full time in the 2020-2021 academic year. College is defined as: a community college, technical/vocational school or a four-year institution of higher education.

### Distribution of scholarship funds:

- Scholarships shall be awarded in the amount of \$1,000.
- Scholarships shall be paid directly to the student's school for tuition, books, fees and related expenses for the 2020-2021 academic year.

**Scholarship selection process:** Scholarship recipients are selected by a committee from the Seattle Housing Authority Higher Education Project through review of completed application materials. Previous Dream Big! Scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply (previous applicants who were <u>not</u> selected for a scholarship may reapply).

#### Criteria for selection include:

- Personal statement or project: applicant writes in their own voice, clearly demonstrates why they
  wish to attend college (including any future plans they may have) and describe qualities and/or
  experiences that demonstrate their ability to succeed.
- Letters of recommendation: writers of letters of recommendation have personal relationships with applicants and provide clear insight into the applicant's present successes and future ability to achieve.
- Transcript: applicant demonstrates achievement, rigor, persistence and/or improvement in their academic career.

**Deadline to apply:** Applications must be submitted to the Dream Big! Scholarship Committee (instructions included on the application form) by **Friday, May 1, 2020.**

# **Dream Big! application packet must include:**

- 1. Your full name on every document submitted.
- 2. A personal statement OR a project (see below).
  - a. Submit a typed **personal statement** of not more than 1,000 words answering <u>all</u> of the following questions:
    - i. Why do you want to pursue post-secondary education? What motivates you?
    - ii. What are your future plans, which relate to earning your degree or certificate?
    - iii. What qualities or experiences have you had that relate to your future success as a student?

#### OR

- b. Submit a **project** (examples include: video, photos, works of art, music, science project, film etc.):
  - i. Project must demonstrate your creativity, talent or a visible achievement.
  - ii. Include a typed 300 350 word explanation of the project that explains how the project answers the questions asked in the personal statement, above.
- 3. **Two letters of recommendation**. The letters must be written by adults who know you well, and who are <u>not</u> related to you. Letters can be written by a teacher, counselor, religious leader, coach, extra-curricular instructor or another person who knows you well. Letters may be submitted in languages other than English. Letters can be included with your application packet or returned to SHA separately via email or postal mail.

Letters should include:

a. Description of the author's relationship to you.

5. A completed **scholarship application form** (page 3 of this packet).

- b. Examples that highlight qualities that will help you be a successful student.
- c. Other information about you they feel would be helpful to the scholarship committee.
- 4. Most up-to-date **high school and/or college transcript** (if in college, please also include your high school transcript).
